## This funding will be used to

- Continue to implement Learning Plans for students who are below a C standard in English and Mathematics and who are below NAPLAN NMS
- Achieve 98% or above of students achieving NMS in Year 3 and Year 5 Reading, Writing, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation and Numeracy
- Increase the % of students achieving C or above in English and Mathematics
- Increase the % of students achieving above level in English and Mathematics
- Increase the relative gain of all assessed students in Reading and Numeracy compared to similar Qld State schools from Year 3 to year 5

## Our initiatives include

- Continue to review and track student performance, utilising diagnostic testing, conducting regular assessment, providing explicit feedback and implementing goal setting and targets
- Continue to provide focussed and intensive teaching for students requiring support to demonstrate achievement against the year level standards
- Improve teacher capability through professional development and coaching to enable all teachers provide explicit instruction and differentiation to cater for individual learning needs.
- Continue to refine our Early Years Strategy and to participate in the Coalition Early Years Strategy.

- Engaging teachers and teacher aides to specifically address the learning needs of students below a C standard and to extend those students achieving a B or above (250,000)

- Purchase additional resources – annual licence renewal for Pat Maths, Reading Eggs, Sound Waves, Mathletics and update PM Benchmark Kits (33,972)
